

GENERAL ELECTION

The deadline to register to vote in the November 4, 2014 General Election Is October 6, 2014

To be eligible to vote in Texas, you must:

- Be a U.S. citizen;
- Be a resident of the county;
- Be 18 years old (you may register at 17 years and 10 months)
- Not a convicted felon (unless a person's sentence is completed, including probation)
- Not declared mentally incapacitated by a court of law.

You must be registered at least thirty days prior to an Election.

Applications to register to vote and for a ballot by mail can now be downloaded at <http://www.rockwallcountytexas.com> or call the Rockwall County Elections Office.

Please mail all applications to: 915 Whitmore Dr., #D, Rockwall, Texas 75087. Voter registration applications are also available at most post offices, libraries and high schools.

If you have registered but don't have a current voter registration certificate (yellow card), please contact the Rockwall County Elections Office at 972-204-6200.

You are only eligible to vote in the precinct where you live if you have registered in that precinct.

If you were registered to vote, but moved from one county in Texas to Rockwall County: *
You will need to register with Rockwall County before being allowed to vote in Rockwall County by the above deadline.

***Limited Ballot**

To vote a Limited Ballots, registered voters who move from one county to another and the person is either still registered in the former county of residence or was registered in the former county of residence when the person applied to register in the new county of residence. Voters are entitled to vote on all statewide races and any district offices that are in common between the old and new counties. Call the Elections Office for details. You may only vote a Limited Ballot during the Early Voting Period (October 20, 2012 through October 31, 2014) at the Main Early Voting location at the Rockwall County Library at 1215 E. Yellowjacket Ln., Rockwall, Texas.

If you moved from city to city within Rockwall County:

You will need to change your voter registration before being allowed to vote in your new precinct by the above deadline.

If you moved from one address in a city to another address within the same city:

You will need to change your voter registration before being allowed to vote in your new precinct by the above deadline.

All updates changing your name or address must be done by mail or in person (no faxes).
